## Corporate Facts

- Naviair is an independent state-owned Air Navigation Service Provider and providing safe, efficient and sustainable aviation infrastructure in Denmark, Greenland and the Faroe Islands.
- Our headquarters is located in Copenhagen, Denmark with additional operational centers in Nuuk, Greenland and in six Danish airports.
- In Denmark our main activities are: en route area control services in Danish airspace, approach control service to Copenhagen Airport, briefing service and Flight Information Services (FIS). This area also includes support and maintenance of radar installations and CNS equipment in Denmark.
- Our activities in Greenland and the Faroe Islands include technical support and maintenance of radar installations and navigation and communication equipment.
- In Greenland our activities also include briefing, FIS and SAR.
- Naviair is owned by the Danish State.

## Operations

- Naviair handled more than 800.000 flights in Danish Airspace in 2018 from our control center in Copenhagen and from our towers in the largest Danish airports.
- No delays in en route traffic in Danish Airspace 361 days out of 365 days in 2018 and the average delay in Danish airspace was 0.6 seconds pr. flight.
- Operates the common Danish-Swedish airspace Bloc (DK-SE FAB) together with Swedish LFV from 3 control centers in Denmark and Sweden.
- DK-SE FAB first with Free Route Airspace in 2011.
- Co-founder of the COOPANS Alliance in 2006 for cooperation 6 European countries on development of harmonized ATC software (currently installed in 7 control centers in Europe).
- Co-founder and co-owner of Entry Point North in 2006 – the largest northern European Air Traffic Service Academy.
- Partner and Co-owner in Aireon.

## Fun Facts

- In 2018, Naviair provided service to 322 different types of airplanes.
- The busiest day in 2018 was Thursday 18 June where we operated 2m191 en route operations.
- Friday is the busiest day in Danish Airspace.
